Tribe HETEROGYNA, *Latr.*

Family I. FORMICIDÆ, *Leach.*

Genus 1. FORMICA.

The maxillary palpi 6-jointed; the labial palpi 4-jointed. Ocelli 3, placed in a triangle on the vertex*. Males and females winged, constantly so in the former sex, temporarily so in the latter. The superior wings with one marginal and two submarginal cells; one division having also a complete discoidal cell, another in which it is obsolete; the petiole of the abdomen furnished with a single vertical scale. None of the individuals furnished with a sting. The pupæ enclosed in silken cocoons.

* In a few species these are obliterated, or scarcely discernible, as in the small workers of *F. flava* and *F. nigra*, &c.
